BENEFITS

- Increase worker satisfaction
- Save money
- Increase productivity
- Reduce distractions/ meetings

- Reduce bias in hiring
- Increase talent pool
- Increase job opportunities
- Save energy/reduce transportation needs

CHALLENGES

- Completely different culture
- Self-discipline
- Home office setup
- FOMO and Imposter
 Syndrome

- Security
- Shift in infrastructure
- Employment/tax law
- Time zones
- Collaboration tools

CULTURE

ALL OR NOTHING?

- · For most orgs, need to pick one or the other
- Mixed environments mean twice the investment
- If you do mix, make sure remote workers aren't second class

ASYNCHRONOUS

- · Value comes from productivity, not desk presence
- Keep meetings & scheduled things to a minimum
- · Get used to new modes of collaboration
- · Bake in respect for different time zones, work schedules
- Increase measuring of outcomes, not activity

INVEST IN ENVIRONMENT

- Avoid temptation of "REMOTE=NO EXPENSES"
- · Create a budget for desks, chairs, ergonomics
- Encourage co-working
- · Generous equipment upgrade/replacement plan





HIRING


- Optimize for people who demonstrate selfreliance
- Interview by working together
- · Pay attention to output, not style or generic fit

COMMUNICATION

- Encourage over-communication
- Default to text-based communication
- Default to sharing everything with everyone
- · Don't trap conversations/decisions in email

MEETUPS


- · Learn personalities, communication styles, humor
- · Realtime work/planning sessions are efficient
- · Co-working helps learn tools, workflow, processes
- Explore new and interesting places
- Usually cheaper than having an office



TOOLS



- · Company-wide channels for announcements, discussion
- Team channels for collaboration and planning
- Private channels or DMs for sensitive topics
- · Great mobile apps, archives, notifications, integrations





PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT

PLANNING

- Start with mockups
- Test-driven where possible
- Development sprints with limit scope
- · Daily "standups"

SHIP EARLY AND OFTEN

- · Ship embarrassing, basic things, then iterate
- "Usage is oxygen for ideas"
- Run tests, collect stats
- Open Source / invite collaboration

PEER CODE REVIEW

- Code Review P2
- Private Github repos with issues, PRs
- Phabricator
- · Clear coding standards and security guidelines
- Commit checklist

ROBUST DEV ENVIRONMENTS

- Use Vagrant to give everyone a production-like sandbox
- Use HockeyApp for mobile
- Struggle with cloning production data
